Privacy Statement

This site is operated by Tesco Ireland Limited, Gresham House, Marine Road, Dun Laoghaire, Co. Dublin.

Tesco is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Statement explains our data processing practices for this site and your options regarding the ways in which your personal data is used.

Any personal data you give us is protected by the Data Protection Acts 1988 and 2003. This provides amongst other things that the data we hold about you should be processed lawfully and fairly and that it should be accurate, relevant and not excessive. The information should, where necessary, be kept up to date and not retained for longer than is necessary. It should be kept securely to prevent unauthorised access by other people. You have the right to see what is held about you and to correct any inaccuracies.

Collection of information

We will collect the information you provide when giving us feedback about Change for Good through this Site or otherwise. We also monitor customer traffic patterns and site use so we can improve this site.

Use of your information and your preferences

We will use the information you give us to adapt and improve our Change for Good initiative. We may use your contact details to communicate with you about competitions that we run in relation to the Change for Good initiative or for administrative or operational reasons relating to this site. We will not contact you for marketing purposes.

Disclosures of your information to third parties

Your information may be passed to and used by other companies in the Tesco Group (being Tesco plc and any of its subsidiaries). We will never pass your personal data to anyone else, except for any successors in title to our business and suppliers that process data on our behalf both in Ireland and abroad. We may also use and disclose information in aggregate (so that no individual customers are identified) for marketing and strategic development purposes.

Cookies

Cookies are small pieces of information sent by a web server to a web browser, which enables the server to collect information from the browser. We use cookies for a number of purposes, for instance to enable us to simplify the logging on process for registered users, to help ensure the security and authenticity of registered users, to provide the mechanisms for online shopping and to enable traffic monitoring.

Non-registered visitors of this site are sent anonymous cookies to keep track of their browsing patterns and build up a demographic profile. In addition, any visitor who has clicked on a Tesco advertisement on another site that links to this site will be sent anonymous cookies that will allow us to analyse advertising effectiveness and manage our relationship with affiliate sites.
